NAM is specifically interested in presenting the award to LLEAs and CPOs who are engaged in new ways of delivering police services to their respective service area(s); are creatively involving the service area as a community partner in a unified effort to solve problems; and are innovatively focusing the energies of the LLEA, via community policing endeavours, to address conditions that give rise to crime and repeated calls for police assistance.

### NOMINATION GUIDELINES

1. Each application must be completed using the PDF interactive form fields, typed or printed in ink and submitted on the accompanying form, a photocopy, or computer-generated exact likeness of the form. No other format will be accepted.
2. Any supporting documentation must accompany the application. Supporting materials may include a letter of support, news clippings, photos, pamphlets, or similar content. All supporting material must be presented on letter-sized paper, 8.5" x 11. No more than three (3) sheets of letter-sized paper with both sides (front and back) being utilized to provide supporting materials. DO NOT submit audio or videotapes, display materials, films, or scrapbooks.
3. Please submit the original and five (5) copies of the completed application form and all supporting materials.
4. Decisions of the selection committee are final. All submitted application forms and submitted material becomes the property of NAM and will NOT be returned.
